Registration Procedures

1. Review Tree Town Cooperative Nursery School class offerings included on the following page. Complete the Tree Town Registration Form for each child indicating your class selection. **Each child must meet the age requirement listed.**
2. Read and sign the Enrollment Contract for each child.
3. Complete the Emergency Health Form for each child.
4. Read the Tree Town Handbook at <http://www.treetown-coop.org/parents>, sign and date the Tree Town Handbook Acknowledgement/Field Trip Waiver/consent/Web Policy Form for each child.
5. Include the \$80 non-refundable registration fee for each child.
6. For new students, provide a copy of their Birth Certificate

Please return the completed and signed forms, registration fee, and Birth Certificate copy (new students only) to the Tree Town office on or before the due date. Current students may turn forms into their child's teacher. Alumni or current students may mail or deliver to the Tree Town office.

We are a non-denominational, non-profit pre-school for children 2-6 years of age and are licensed by the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services. The Pat Collins Scholarship is available for those families demonstrating financial aid. Donations are welcome to maintain our scholarship fund.

CLASS OFFERINGS 2022 – 2023

Two Year Old Classes

This class meets one day per week. You may choose to enroll your child in both days. The class is staffed by 3 teachers and one parent helper. The class enrollment is capped at 12 students and has an adult/child ratio of 1 to 3. A parent will be required to help in your child's class 2-3 times per year. Goals for 2's include but are not limited to: learning finger plays and nursery rhymes, learning to sit for a story, finger strengthening art activities, and learning to play with others.

Three Year Old Classes

This class meets two days per week. This class maintains a teacher/child ratio of 1 to 5. The class enrollment is capped at 16 students. Goals for 3's include but are not limited to: learning to recognize letters, shapes, and writing his/her first name, learning numbers, and working on fine motor skills of cutting and writing. Parents are not required to help, but have an opportunity to be in the classroom approximately 3 times per year.

Four Year Old Classes

This class meets three days per week. This class maintains a teacher/child ratio of 1 to 6. Goals for 4's include but are not limited to: letter and sound recognition, writing first and last name, counting 1-20, and introduction to sight words. Preparing your child for kindergarten academically and socially is one of the main focuses of this class. Parents are not required to help, but have an opportunity to be in the classroom approximately 3-4 times per year.

Kid Town Kindergarten Enrichment

This class meets two days per week. This class maintains a teacher/child ratio of 1 to 12. Kid Town is a kindergarten enrichment program which reinforces phonetic and mathematical concepts learned in kindergarten in a thematic and fun setting. To enroll in enrichment, students must be in the Tuesday/Thursday Kid Town class. Helping is not required in Kid Town.

I understand that when I enroll my child in Tree Town Cooperative Nursery School, I agree to become a member of the Tree Town Parents' Association. As a member of this Association, I agree to the following:

1. Payment of a non-refundable \$80 registration fee.
2. Payment of tuition in three installments on April 4, 2022, October 3, 2022 (includes snack fee) & February 1, 2023

A \$20.00 late fee will be assessed for 1-7 days

A \$50.00 late fee after 7days unless arrangements have been made with the treasurer.

3. To notify the Registrar immediately in the event my child is unable to complete the school year so that the vacancy can be filled.
4. Should I withdraw my child from school after this contract has been entered into and the vacancy cannot be filled, I agree to pay a withdrawal fee of 10% of total tuition.
5. Members shall be allowed to withdraw prior to the end of the school year without responsibility for full year tuition only in the following cases:
 1. Serious or prolonged illness;
 2. Permanent move of the family from the community;
 3. Mutual agreement between the member and the Parent Board if there is an unsatisfactory adjustment of the child to the School or of the member as a participant. In such cases, withdrawal shall take effect upon one month's written notice to the Registrar and Treasurer. That month's tuition will be retained and any remaining tuition will be refunded.
6. The teacher and/or Parent Board may request that a member withdraw their child from the school if the child's needs cannot be met or if the child's presence is preventing the teacher from meeting the needs of the rest of the class.
7. To keep my child home if he/she shows symptoms of a cold or other communicable disease.

I understand and agree that the Board of Directors of Tree Town Cooperative Nursery School maintains the right to terminate the membership of any member who fails to fulfill any of the above obligations.
